## **The Renewable Energy Grant and Loan Opportunity committee regrets to announce that the REGLO program has been suspended until further notice.**

This popular REGLO program was created to help Kingston residents in their efforts to make their homes more energy efficient and to install renewable energy generation projects such as home solar.

Since the creation of the REGLO program in 2015, we have awarded over \$125,000 in grants to Kingston residents. Grant recipients have documented investing over \$1,660,000 in home energy saving upgrades and renewable energy installations.

The source of grant funds for this program is determined by town revenues produced by our renewable energy installations on town properties. Funds resulting from the only current installation, the Independence Wind Turbine located on the town's capped landfill, have been completely expended at this time.

When future funds become available, the committee will announce that the program is re-opened and will start accepting new applications that meet the criteria for awards within that program year.

We wish to thank all Kingston residents whose investments in new, energy efficient technology and renewable energy generation as they have contributed significantly towards our communities overall reduction in green-house gas emissions.

It is our sincere hope that this program will re-open ASAP. REGLO committee also hopes our residents will continue to make the effort to reduce your overall energy use every day and consider renewable energy for your home.
