## What is CERP

- In 2018, MassDEP, the Department of Energy Resources (DOER), & the MA Clean Energy Center (CEC) announced grant funding for clean energy initiatives for wastewater & drinking water facilities across the Commonwealth. This funding will help fast track **\$17 MILLION** in Clean Energy improvements for cities and towns!



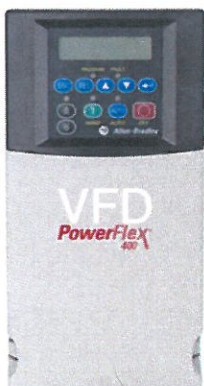

## Kingston

- Received \$76,020.00 to Upgrade boiler system at the Kingston Wastewater Treatment Plant
- \$10,136 by town, and along other grants/incentives means the project is fully funded!
- 1.83 years until the project pays for itself

- A long time goal of MassDEP is to help public utilities reach a Zero-Net status, This means that the facilities produce their own renewable energy for operations, on site. Increasing the energy efficiency of water utilities is a big step in this direction
